

KLAUS PETER BERGER is professor of domestic and international business and banking law, comparative and private international law at the University of Cologne, director of the Institute for Banking Law and the Center for Transnational Law (CENTRAL) at the Cologne law faculty and Honorary Lecturer and Member of the Global Faculty, Centre for Energy, Petroleum and Mineral Law and Policy, University of Dundee, Scotland. Between 1996 and 2002, he was professor of international business law at Münster University and director of the Institute for International Business Law at the Münster law faculty.

Professor Berger has acted as sole arbitrator, party-appointed arbitrator and chairman in ICC-, Zurich Chamber of Commerce-, Austrian Federal Economic Chamber, LCIA-, UNCITRAL and Ad Hoc-arbitrations. He is a member of the panel of arbitrators of the China International Economic Trade Arbitration Commission (CIETAC, Beijing, China) and of the International Centre for Dispute Resolution (international division, American Arbitration Association, AAA). He is also on the list of arbitrators of the International Arbitration Centre of the Austrian Federal Economic Chamber. He was a member of the Arbitration Law Reform Commission at the German Institution of Arbitration (DIS).
